Chapter 15 – Statistics

Assign Students:

- 6) Lesson 146 – Chapter Review #1-22

Other skills needed:

1. Review and make sure students have all multiplication facts memorized up to the 10s. They should be able to automatically respond with the correct product for each fact. Especially, make sure they have the 6s, 7s, and 8s.

2. Practice multiplying and dividing numbers by multiples of tens.

Example:

$43 \times 1 = 43$	$43/1 = 43$
$43 \times 10 = 430$	$43/10 = 4.3$
$43 \times 100 = 4,300$	$43/100 = .43$
$43 \times 1000 = 43,000$	$43/1000 = .043$
